





AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 19404 OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 19, TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ENFORCEMENT OF RULES PROMULGATED IN AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RELATIVE TO A DECLARED EMERGENCY TO PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §19404 of Article 4, Chapter 19, Title 10 Guam Code Annotated is amended to read:

“§ 19404. Enforcement.

(a) During a state of public health emergency, the public health authority may request assistance in enforcing orders pursuant to this Chapter from the public safety authority. The public safety authority may request assistance from the organized militia in enforcing the orders of the public health authority.

(b) Any person found to be in violation of an Executive Order promulgated by *I Maga'hâgan Guåhan* during a declared emergency to health or safety in the exercise of authority under this Chapter or 10 GCA Chapter 65, shall be guilty of a

1 misdemeanor. Upon conviction, the person shall be fined not more than \$5,000, or
2 imprisoned not more than one year, or both.”

3 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
4 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
5 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect
6 without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this
7 Act are severable.

8 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
