Re: Ongoing Aggravated Assault Investigation

On Wednesday June 24, the Guam Police Department launched an Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer complaint that occurred within the parking of the Central Precinct Command in Sinajana.

Preliminary police reports suggest that at around 10:18am, a complainant had arrived at the Central Precinct Command to initiate a stalking complaint relative to the victim's estranged boyfriend. While at the precinct, the victim had flagged down a marked patrol cruiser that was motoring within the parking and informed the officers of the situation.

As the officers proceeded to ascertain more information from a male who was operating a blue BMW within the parking lot and for unknown reasons, the BMW accelerated towards the marked patrol cruiser and struck the patrol cruiser.

The BMW then fled from the parking lot and onto Route 4, where the BMW collided with a Toyota Highlander that was traveling northbound on Route 4, Sinajana. The blue BMW was last seen by witnesses entering Sinajana village.

As a result of the incident, all parties involved in the crash were treated by GFD medical personnel. This case is ongoing as a person of interest has been identified.
