After reviewing and scoring grant applications submitted in response to the Office of Insular Affairs (OIA) 2020 Technical Assistance Program (TAP) notice, I am pleased to award funding to the Government of Guam for the following projects:

- \$719,959.60 to the Guam State Clearinghouse for the Digital Archiving Project, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 1, 2020;
- \$499,991.50 to the Guam State Clearinghouse for the Public Library System Archival Center Assistance Program, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 1, 2020;
- \$366,989 to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for training and improvements to the Nursing Division and training for the Revenue Cycle Management Staff, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 1, 2020;
- \$310,000 to the Office of the Attorney General for the Forensic and Accounting Training Project, as detailed in the proposal submitted on April 8, 2020;
- \$309,828 to the Department of Land Management for the enhancement of their technology infrastructure, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 1, 2020;
- \$300,500 to the Bureau of Statistics and Plans for the Customs and Import Operations Modernization, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 1, 2020;
- \$95,175 to the Department of Education Internal Audit Office for the training program, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 31, 2020;
- \$44,200 to the Department of Public Works for a new CCTV system, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 31, 2020; and
- \$14,000 to the Department of Public Works for the Inventory Barcode Program Software Project, as detailed in the proposal submitted on May 31, 2020.

OIA is also awarding TAP funding in the amount of \$334,260 to the University of Guam for the Training Capacity Project for the Guam Cultural Repository.
