Subj: TEMPORARY OFF-LIMITS DECLARATION ICO MCKRAUT'S

1. In accordance with references (a) and (b), effective immediately, McKraut's restaurant in Inajaran, Guam is hereby declared temporarily off-limits to U.S. Armed Forces personnel temporarily or permanently assigned within Joint Region Marianas due to repeated failures to comply with COVID-19 mitigation measures required by reference (c). Guam remains in a declared public health emergency, and the COVID-19 pandemic poses a distinct risk to the military mission throughout the Joint Region Marianas area of operations. In light of this establishment's repeated citations for creating undesirable public health conditions which are unsafe and may adversely affect the health and well-being of military personnel and their families, McKraut's is temporarily off-limits for military personnel pending further determination by the next Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board.

2. Per references (a) and (b), Armed Forces personnel are prohibited from entering establishments declared to be off-limits. Violations of this declaration may be subject to disciplinary or administrative action under the Uniform Code of Military Justice and applicable regulations.
