### War in the Pacific National Historical Park Selected for Teacher Ranger Teacher Program

HAGÁTÑA –This summer, War in the Pacific National Historical Park has been selected to participate in the Teacher Ranger Teacher (TRT) program. The purpose of the program is to provide teachers an opportunity to learn about National Park Service (NPS) educational resources and themes while earning continuing education credits through a partnership between the NPS and the University of Colorado, Denver.

Working with park rangers, the participating teacher will spend approximately 240 hours developing lesson plans with a virtual component for local and off-island students, as well as completing three graduate credit hours of coursework in Experiential Learning online. Additional opportunities may also be available to engage students with the park's resources. This work is expected to be offered in one of two cohorts: June 12 - July 30 or July 10 - August 20. Upon successful completion of the program, the teacher will receive a \$3,000 stipend from the university. The program will begin mid-June.

K-12 grade teachers are invited to apply. Please note that some work for this summer's program will be completed remotely and the selected teacher must have access to a computer and internet. The deadline to apply is May 19, 2022.
