Subject: Local Task Force; Arrested Person

The Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency (CQA) and the Guam Police Department (GPD), coordinated their efforts today to make a second arrest on an individual who is believed to have unlawfully arrived into Guam via boat from the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI). The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) assisted in the investigation.

Haize LU, 37 years of age, Chinese, was arrested on suspicion of Failure to Acquire Clearance Requirements, Failure to Deliver a Manifest to a Customs Officer and Invalid Place of Unloading. He was booked and confined to the Department of Corrections.

The case has been forwarded to the OAG for their review.

These efforts are part of the recently organized multi-agency task force established by Governor Lou Leon Guerrero that was created in response to the recent increase in unlawful arrivals into Guam by boat, and includes CQA, Guam Homeland Security, GPD, the OAG, Guam Department of Agriculture, Guam Department of Labor, Guam Fire Department, Guam Homeland Security, Guam Police Department, and Port Authority of Guam.
